

Scholarship Protocol

Colony Men's Golf Club

A. HIGH SCHOOLS ELIGIBLE

- a. Murrieta Mesa
- b. Murrieta Valley
- c. Vista Murrieta

B. RESOURCES PROVIDED BY THE COLONY MEN'S GOLF CLUB

- a. Funds provided not to exceed **\$3,000** per year
 - i. Total funds will be determined by CMGC Board based upon annual budget dollars available
- b. Maximum scholarship of **\$1,000** per student
- c. Scholarship funds will be distributed evenly between winners based upon the number of students who qualify for scholarship each year

C. SCHOLARSHIP CONSIDERATIONS

- a. CMGC
 - i. Student must be a member of the High Schools Golf Team
 - ii. Student must be college or trade school bound
 - iii. Student must have maintained a GPA of 3.0 or better
 - iv. Special considerations may be considered with approval by the CMGC Board with the input of the Golf Teams Coaches
 - v. Students receiving "Full Ride Scholarships"
- b. Golf Team Coaches
 - i. Qualifying students will be nominated by the High School coaches
 - ii. Qualities of the nominated students may be submitted for consideration
 1. Character
 2. Financial need
 - a. Students receiving "Full Ride Scholarships" are ineligible
 3. Justification for nominee if less than a 3.0 GPA

D. DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS

- a. Gender will not be a consideration for recipients [i.e. one boy one girl]
- b. Funds will be distributed to ALL qualifying Senior College or Trade School Bound Golf student who meet the criteria noted above
 - i. All schools can submit nominees that meet criteria
 - ii. The Budgeted scholarship dollars will be distributed equally to awardees
 1. EXAMPLE 1: **\$3,000** with three qualified students = **\$1,000** / student
 2. EXAMPLE 2: **\$3,000** with five qualified students = **\$600** / student
 3. EXAMPLE 3: **\$3,000** with one qualified student = **\$1,000** / student
 - a. The remainder of funds will be returned to the CMGC treasury
 - iii. Awardee failing to submit to CMGC requested data to establish college or trade school ID account will forfeit funds which will be returned to the CMGC treasury
 - iv. Unused scholarship funds returned to CMGC from college[s] or trade school[s] will be returned to the CMGC treasury

E. SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT AND LUNCHEON

- a. Costs associated with Green Fees and Luncheon will be underwritten for the student and his/her coach by the CMGC and Cal Oaks Golf Course.
 - i. All Scholarship winners can participate as well as "Full Ride Scholarship" awardees
